DAYA CHAUDHARY, J.

The present petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing respondents No.1 to 4 to terminate the services of respondents No.5 to 13 on the ground that the said respondents have not passed the Safety Code test as mentioned in their appointment letters.

Learned counsel for the petitioners contends that the petitioners would be satisfied in case directions are issued to respondents No.1 to 4 to decide their legal notice dated 24.5.2017 (Annexure P12) as no action has been taken thereupon so far.

Keeping in view the limited prayer of the petitioners, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2 to consider the legal notice of the petitioners dated 24.5.2017 (Annexure P-12) and pass necessary order in accordance with law within a period of two months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of the order.

Disposed of accordingly.
