The petitioner who states that he is President of Asha Deep Welfare Society for persons with Intellectual and Developmental Disabilities (PWIDDC) Chandigarh has filed the present petition in the nature of PIL under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for directing respondents No.1 to 4 to immediately order an inquiry or investigation or complete such inquiry or investigation where already ordered in respect of the complaint-cum-legal notice dated 29.06.2016 (Annexure P-5) submitted by the petitioner and to initiate prosecution of the management of the respondent No.5 society for various illegal and exploitative practices including violation of various laws in relation to Employees Welfare Fund and Employees State Insurance Contribution for the employees and also the Minimum Wages Act

Learned counsel for the petitioner seeks permission to withdraw the petition so as to avail other alternative remedies in the first instance.

Accordingly, the petition is dismissed as withdrawn. However, the question of *locus standi* to file the PIL and also maintainability of the PIL on his behalf are kept open.
