Petitioner is a miller and has filed this petition under Section 226 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a direction to respondents No. 5 and 6 to settle the claim of the petitioner-mill in respect of 'B' class and 'C' class surplus gunny bags retained by the petitioner-miller for the crop year 2007-08 and 2013-14 as per the guidelines dated 24.05.2013 Annexure P-6.

In this context, the petitioner appears to have submitted a legal notice to the Managing Director, MARKFED, MARKFED Bhawan, Sector 35, Chandigarh and the District Manager, MARKFED District Office Sangrur, Annexure P-16.

In the interest of justice, this petition is disposed of with a direction that legal notice Annexure P-16 dated 21.01.2017 will be considered by the Managing Director, MARKFED, MARKFED Bhawan, Sector 35, Chandigarh and the District Manager, MARKFED, District Office Sangrur within a period of two months after the receipt of certified copy of this order.

It will be the responsibility of the petitioner to communicate the directions to respondents No. 5 and 6.
