This petition is filed for the issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus, directing respondents No.1 & 3 to conduct comprehensive audit of the school funds of respondent No.6.

During the course of hearing, learned counsel for the State, on instructions received from Ram Niwas Gupta, Assistant, Director Secondary Education, Haryana, has admitted that the order passed by the Funds Regulatory Committee dated 24.7.2015 has not been challenged in appeal and has attained finality. She has rather submitted that the respondents have decided to comply with the said order and requested for three months time to do the needful.

Learned counsel for the petitioner is satisfied with the statement made by counsel for the State.

Consequently, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondents No.1 and 3 to comply with the order dated 24.7.2015, for the purpose of conducting the audit of the school funds of respondent No.6, within a period of three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order. In case, the order is not complied with, the petitioner may, if so advised, avail the remedy of filing application for revival of this petition or for initiating contempt proceedings.
