Learned counsel for the petitioner, during the course of hearing, has submitted that the argument raised before the Financial Commissioner has not been dealt with though he himself was the counsel before him. If that is the situation, the petitioner, instead of filing the writ petition against the impugned order, should have filed a review application in terms of section 15 of the Punjab Land Revenue Act, 1887.

Faced with this observation, learned counsel for the petitioner prays for withdrawal of the petition to first file review application before the Financial Commissioner. In case, any such application for review is filed within 15 days from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order, the Financial Commissioner shall not raise any objection to the limitation and shall entertain the same.

Dismissed as with drawn.
