JASWANT SINGH, J.(ORAL)

29 Petitioners substantively working in the rank of Assistant Sub Inspectors claimed to have successfully passed the required Upper School Course ending on 15/12/2016 and also possesses more than 05 years stipulated experience for promotion as Sub Inspector within their prescribed promotional quota.

The grievance of the petitioner is that inspite of the promotional PIPING ceremony in the rank of Sub Inspectors itself having been conducted on 15.12.2016, no promotional orders were being issued.

Upon notice learned State Counsel on instructions from Mr. Devinder Singh, DSP, O/o ADGP Vigilance, Punjab submits that for promotion to the post of Sub Inspector apart from passing of the prescribed

Upper School Course, the meeting of DPC has also to be held to ensure that the required criteria of seniority cum merit is also fulfilled. She further submits that the recommendations of the DPC held on 17.03.2017 have been sent for approval.

The relief claimed by the petitioners regarding declaring them as senior in the rank of Sub Inspectors to the directly recruited sub inspectors pursuant to the advertisement dated 08.09.2016 (**P-4**) is totally misplaced at this stage when they have not even become members of the service.

In view of the above, present writ petition is hereby dismissed.
