Vide impugned order passed by Debts Recovery Appellate Tribunal (for short “the Tribunal”) prima facie finding that there was disobedience of the directions issued by the Tribunal, General Manager has been directed to file his affidavit, while appearing in person in Court on the next date of hearing i.e. on 13.10.2017.

Considering the fact that the matter has not finally been disposed of by the Tribunal and merely a show cause notice has been issued, we do not find it appropriate to entertain the present petition at this stage. The order of the Tribunal be complied with. In case any order adverse to the petitioner is passed by the Tribunal, the petitioner may avail of its appropriate remedy at that stage.

The petition stands disposed of accordingly.
