By this petition the petitioner has claimed that the respondents are bound to consider the daily wages service (which was converted to regular service without any gap) be counted for retiral benefits.

Learned counsel states that in this connection the petitioner has also moved a Legal notice dated 13.09.2017 (Annexure P-5) and at this stage he would be satisfied if a direction be given to the respondent No.3 to decide the said legal notice in accordance with law and grant the necessary relief to the petitioner by passing a speaking order thereon within any reasonable time.

I find this to be a fair submission. In the circumstances, this petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondent No.3 to decide the said legal notice expeditiously by passing a speaking order and, in case the petitioner is found entitled to the relief claimed grant the same to her within a period of 4 months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this

It is further made clear that if any due relief is not granted to the petitioner, the petitioner would be entitled to claim the same with interest @ 8% per annum from the date/s the amount/s fell due till the date of payment.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending Civil Misc. Application, if any, also stands disposed of.
