By virtue of instant petition preferred under Articles 226/227 of Constitution of India, petitioner has sought a writ in the nature certiorari for setting aside the communication/letter dated October 21, 2014 (P-3) with further prayer for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to decide the legal notice dated May 08, 2017 (P-12) and to refix his pay as claimed in the afore-said legal notice and also to release him entire arrears.

2. At the very outset, it has been submitted by learned counsel for the petitioner that though legal notice dated May 08, 2017 (P-12) was duly served upon the respondents but till date no conscious decision has been taken. He further submits that petitioner feels satisfied in case direction is issued to respondents to decide the afore-said legal notice, within a stipulated period.

3. Accordingly, instant petition is disposed of with a direction to respondents to look into the grievances unfolded by the petitioner in his legal notice (P-12) and to decide the same in accordance with law, service rules and instructions issued by Government from time to time that too, by passing a speaking order and after giving a patient hearing to the petitioner, within a period of four months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.

4. However, in case petitioner still feels aggrieved by any order of the afore-said authority, he shall be at liberty to approach this Court.
