Learned counsel for the petitioner seeks withdrawal of the present writ petition provided that period spent in the present writ petition be condoned by taking the aid of provision of Section 14 of the Limitation Act.

Mr. Akshay Bhan, learned Senior Counsel assisted by Mr. Amandeep Singh Talwar, Advocate for respondent No.6 submits that he has no objection but the period of limitation may not be condoned.

Dispute in the present writ petition is with regard to the adjudication of the representation regarding the alleged embezzlement of crores of rupees with regard to the illegal gratification and payment from

contesting candidates for general election. The petitioner has a independent remedy either by suit or other means. In case, such remedy is availed within a period of two months from the date of receipt of certified copy of the order, period spent herein shall deemed to be condoned.

Respondent(s) shall be at liberty to take all possible objection in accordance with law in any of the forum where proceedings are intended to be initiated.

With the aforementioned observation, present writ petition stands disposed of.
