The petitioner has approached this Court under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of *certiorari*, quashing the impugned order (Annexure P-5) passed by respondent No.1, whereby the technical bid of the petitioner has been rejected. A further writ of *certiorari* has been sought for quashing the awarding of the contract by respondent No.1 in favour of respondent No.2.

2. After arguing for sometime, learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that he may be allowed to withdraw the present writ petition with liberty to the petitioner to approach respondent No.1 by filing a detailed and comprehensive representation.
