By this petition the petitioner seeks direction to the respondents to give the benefits of regularization to the petitioner w.e.f. 01.04.2011 i.e. the day when the services of the juniors to the petitioners were regularized.

Learned counsel states that in this connection the petitioner has also moved Legal Notice dated 17.09.2016 (Annexure P-4) to the respondents and at this stage he would be satisfied if decision is taken thereon by the respondent No.3 within any reasonable time.

I find this to be a fair submission. Keeping in view the

plight as portrayed, I deem it appropriate to dispose of this petition with a

direction to the respondent No.3 to decide the said legal notice of the petitioner by passing a speaking order thereon within a period of three months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order. Ordered accordingly.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending civil miscellaneous application, if any, also stands disposed of.
