The petitioners have approached this Court under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, seeking a writ in the nature of Certiorari, for quashing the impugned notices dated 11th July, 2016 (Annexures P-2 to P-8) issued under Section 13(2) of the Securitization and Reconstruction of the Financial Assets & Enforcement of Security Interest Act, 2002 (in short 'the Act') and impugned notices dated 17th October, 2016 (Annexures P-18 to P-21), issued under the Act, by respondent No.2, which are stated to be issued on the basis of forged and fabricated documents and even without deciding the reply/objections dated 05.09.2016 filed by the petitioners (appended as Annexure P-9 along with the writ petition).

2. After arguing for sometime, when the Bench did not agree with the learned counsel for the petitioners, a prayer was made by him that he may be allowed to withdraw the present writ petition with liberty to the petitioners to file the objections before the appropriate Forum.

3. Dismissed as withdrawn. It shall, however, be open to the

petitioners to take recourse to the remedies as may be available to them, in accordance with law.
