By virtue of instant petition preferred under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, petitioner has sought the issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to step up his pay equal or above to respondent No.4, who is junior to him.

2. At the very outset, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that respondents were served upon legal notice dated March 09, 2017 (P-3), which did not fetch any response till date. He further submits that he feels satisfied in case a direction is issued to respondent No.2 to consider and dispose of the legal notice (P-3) within a time bound manner.

3. Accordingly, instant petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.3 to look into the grievances unfolded by the petitioner in the legal notice (P-3) and to take a conscious decision in accordance with law

within a period of three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order. In the event, of passing of any adverse order, petitioner shall be at liberty to approach this Court.
