The case of the petitioner is that a plot measuring 6 biswa comprising in khewat No.738/677, khatoni No.998, khasra No.1737, situated in the revenue estate of village Saron, District Sangrur was purchased by the petitioner's father in an open auction conducted by the Gram Panchayat on 12.04.1969, for a consideration of Rs.500/-. A resolution passed by the Gram Panchayat is also appended. It is further averred that father of the petitioner constructed a house over the site. The petitioner has also constructed a new house at the site which is continuously in their possession. The petitioner's grievance is that despite resolution and recommendations by the Gram Panchayat, no 'sale certificate' is issued so far despite running from pillar to post. A representation dated 31.03.2017 (P-8) is also said to have been made by the petitioner. It is further stated that the 'sale certificate' is to be issued by the Deputy Director, Land Development Branch, Department of Rural Development and Panchayat, Punjab.

The writ petition is accordingly disposed of at this stage

to verify the records and if claim put-forth by the petitioner is found correct, let necessary action be taken within a period of four months from the date of receiving a certified copy of this order.
