Grievance of the petitioner is that petitioner is debarred from applying for any petrol LPG outlet in the SC category as there is a policy that he is supposed to possess land and godown prior to the date of application. He submits that such a policy is discriminatory. The matter has been reconsidered by this court in **CWP No.3198 of 2014 titled Sunita Rani Vs. Union of India and others** wherein certain directions have been given. Admittedly, petitioner is not applicant at present for any outlet/agency. Thus, this court does not find any ground to interfere in the writ jurisdiction. Needless to observe that in case petitioner applies for any such agency/distributorship, he shall be at liberty to rely upon judgment passed in Sunita Rani'case (supra).
