Prayer in the present application is for disposal of the main writ
petition (CWP No. 3370 of 2015) in terms of the order dated 28.02.2017
passed in CWP No. 12568 of 2013 (Annexure A-1).

CM is allowed and the main writ petition (CWP No. 3370 of
2015) is taken on the Board.

The issue raised in the petition is regarding re-determination of
the compensation for the land acquired by the Jalandhar Improvement Trust,

Jalandhar.

On 25.02.2015, while issuing notice of motion, the writ petition was directed to be heard along with CWP No. 3045 of 2015. The aforesaid writ petition has been disposed of along with CWP No. 12568 of 2013, **Manjit Singh Vs. The Land Acquisition Collector, Jalandhar Improvement Trust, Jalandhar and others,** on 28.02.2017.

Learned counsel appearing for respondent No.2 fairly submitted that the issue raised in the present petition is squarely covered by the decision of this Court in **Manjit Singh's case** (supra).

After hearing learned counsel for the parties and considering the submissions made, we are of the opinion that the present petition can be disposed of in terms of the order dated 28.02.2017 passed in **Manjit Singh's case** (supra).
