**CM No. 6882-CWP of 2013**

This is an application for impleading the legal representatives  
of deceased petitioner no.1, who died on 3.3.2013. It is stated in the

application that the deceased left behind five legal heirs.

For the reasons mentioned in the application, the applicants are impleaded as legal representatives of the aforesaid deceased petitioner. However, it is made clear that this order shall be considered only for the purpose of representation of the aforesaid deceased before this Court.

Amended memo of parties annexed with the application is taken on record.

RA-CW No. 431-CWP of 2008

Review Application was withdrawn qua applicant no. 2 vide order dated 22.8.2016.

Review of the order dated 30.10.2007 passed by this Court dismissing the writ petition has been sought, on the ground that there is hostile discrimination as initially the land measuring 53 acres sought to be acquired when notification under Section 4 of the Land Acquisition Act, 1894 was issued, however, finally award was announced only for 13.4087 acres. Even thereafter portions of land were released. Entire area around the land is sought to be acquired is developed by DLF and in fact, the same is known as DLF Sector. The land is located in small-small different pockets and hence, cannot possibly be utilized by the State. In fact, the acquisition has been made on behest of the DLF and is ultimately to be transferred to it.

Keeping in view the aforesaid facts and the site plan produced by learned counsel for the State in Court, in our opinion, the order dated 30.10.2007 dismissing the writ petition deserves to be re-called and the writ petition heard on merits, even though in order dated 15.1.2010, it was

recorded that notice is pertaining to release of land after dismissal of the writ petition.

Ordered accordingly.

The main writ petition is taken up for hearing and is disposed of by a separate order.
