The petitioner seeks a writ in the nature of mandamus under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for directing the respondents to release the benefit of 1st ACP due w.e.f. 19.11.2013 alongwith interest and all consequential benefits.

Similarly, the special allowance of the petitioner for the period from 03.12.2016 to 31.03.2017 on account of having worked on deputation at BPS GMC for Women, Khanur Kalan (Sonapat) is also prayed for, in view of the circular dated 17.02.2011 (Annexure P-5).

It is the case of the petitioner that the above said benefits have not been granted and two representations have been moved regarding the first aspect to respondent No.2 on 09.12.2016 (Annexure P-2) and 26.12.2016 (Annexure P-3). Similarly, he has also represented for his special allowance for his posting in College at Sonapat vide communications dated 16.02.2017 (Annexure P-6) and 24.07.2017 (Annexure P-7).

Notice of motion.

Ms. Shruti Jain Goyal, AAG, Haryana accepts notice on behalf of the respondents. Copies of the paper book have been supplied to her.

Keeping in view the above, since the decision making process is not complete, no useful purpose will be served by calling upon the respondents to file reply.

Accordingly, without commenting upon the merits of the case or the entitlement of the petitioner, the present writ petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2 to take a decision on the said issue within a period of 3 months from the receipt of the certified copy of this order.

Needless to say that, in case, any adverse order is to be passed, the same be conveyed to the petitioner by passing a speaking order.
