AJAY KUMAR MITTAL, J. (Oral)

1. This order shall dispose of two writ petitions bearing CWP Nos.27360 and 14154 of 2016 as identical issue has been raised therein. For brevity, the facts are being extracted from CWP No.27360 of 2016.

2. The challenge in this petition filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India is to the order-in-original No.141-142/CE/CHD-II/2016 (**Annexure P-1**) passed by respondent No.2.

3. At the outset, learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that since the impugned order (Annexure P-1) is an appealable order, he may be allowed to withdraw the present writ petition along with civil misc. applications with liberty to the petitioner(s) to avail alternate remedy of appeal before the appellate authority in accordance with law.

4. Accordingly, both the writ petitions stand dismissed as withdrawn.

5. It shall, however, be open to the petitioner(s) to take recourse to the remedies as may be available to it, in accordance with law.
