In this case it is the stand of the petitioner-college that its students have been illegally denied permission to sit in the 2nd year exam which are scheduled to be start from 15.11.2017. The case of the respondents on the other hand is that the last date for submission of form was 31.7.2017 without late fee and if the petitioner wants its students to sit in the exam it can even now submit their form with late fee up to 12.10.2017 which is the date on which present petition was filed. To counter his argument learned counsel for the petitioner has stated that the petitioner had approached the respondents by letter dated 16.8.2017 and therefore they are liable to pay late fee up till that date. The receipt of this letter has been denied. Counsel for the petitioner has then stated that the petitioner would pay late fee up to the date of filing of the writ petition. Counsel for the respondents states that he has no objection in permitting the students to take the exam if fee is paid up to the date of

filing of the writ petition alongwith the necessary documentation.

Petition stands disposed of.
