This petition has been filed by 27 teachers claiming that pursuant to their transfer orders they have tried to join at the respective posts but those posts not being vacant they have not been allowed to join and consequently have not been given salary.

Learned counsel states that in this connection the petitioners have also moved a representation (Annexure P-7) to the respondents and at this stage they would be satisfied if this representation is decided by the respondent No.3 within any reasonable time.

I find this to be a fair submission. Keeping in view the

plight as portrayed, I deem it appropriate to dispose of this petition with a

direction to the respondent No.3 to decide the said representation of the petitioners and take necessary action thereon within a period of four weeks from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order. Ordered accordingly.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending civil miscellaneous application, if any, also stands disposed of.
