Vide order dated 9.2.2017, this Court has passed the following order:

“The petitioner has questioned the rejection of her rejoining of service. The petitioner while working as Stenographer Grade-II has applied for the post of Steno Typist in Punjab Agriculture University, Ludhiana. She was selected on 11.7.2016. She had submitted resignation application on 14.7.2016. Before acceptance of her resignation on 8.8.2016, the petitioner has reported in the Agriculture University on 17.8.2016. Due to personal reason, the petitioner submitted an application for withdrawal of resignation on 22.8.2016 that is much after acceptance of her resignation on 8.8.2016.

Learned counsel for the petitioner relies on Rule 3.12 of the Punjab Civil Services Rules Vol.I Part-I under chapter Substantive Appointment and Lien to contend that the petitioner had lien over the post of Stenographer-Grade-II in the judicial department.

Once the resignation has been accepted on 8.8.2016, relation between employer and employee ceases. Therefore, question of lien in the judicial department would not arise.

At this stage, learned counsel for the petitioner

seeks time to place on record Rules and Law on the subject.

List this matter on 3.3.2017.”

Pursuant to the order dated 9.2.2017, learned counsel for the petitioner relied on Rule 7.5 of C.C.R. Rule Volume-I.

Perusal of the said Rule, nowhere it is stated that after acceptance of resignation, resignation matter could be re-considered by the competent authority. Thus, the petitioner has not made out a case so as to interfere with the order dated 1.10.2016 (Annexure P-10).

Accordingly, the present petition stands dismissed.
