By virtue of instant petition preferred under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, petitioner has sought the issuance of writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to release the fixed financial benefits of 2nd Financial Upgradation under the Assured Career Progression Scheme, 1999 w.e.f. 05.02.2004 alongwith arrears and interest with further direction for issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari to quash the order dated March 08, 2017 (Annexure P-4).

2. At the very outset, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that he moved various representations on January 06, May 26 and July 12, 2017 respectively but till date no final decision has been taken by the respondents. Even, he also served legal notice dated July 27, 2017 (Annexure P-7) upon the respondents, yet it did not fetch any reply. He further submits that he feels

satisfied in case a direction is issued to respondents to consider and dispose of the legal notice (Annexure P-7) within a time bound period.

3. Accordingly, instant petition is disposed of with a direction to respondents to look into the grievances unfolded by the petitioner in the legal notice dated July 27, 2017 (Annexure P-7) and to take a conscious decision in accordance with law within a period of three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order. However, if the petitioner still feels aggrieved by any order of the afore-said authority, he shall be at liberty to approach this Court.
