The challenge in this petition filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, is to the order dated 24.08.2017 (Annexure P-6) (colly.) as well as to the additional demand notice dated 26.09.2017 (Annexure P-8) (colly.)

It was not disputed by learned counsel that the order of re-assessment dated 24.08.2017 (Annexure P-6) (colly.), is an appealable order and accordingly, a prayer was made that he may be allowed to withdraw the present writ petition with liberty to the petitioners to avail the statutory remedy of appeal in accordance with law.

3. Dismissed as withdrawn. It shall, however, be open to the petitioners to take recourse to the remedies as may be available to them, in accordance with law.
