By virtue of instant petition preferred under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, petitioner has sought the issuance of writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to grant him proficiency step ups after 4 and 9 years of service from 16.08.2009 and 16.08.2014 respectively as per Government instructions dated 03.11.2006 (Annexure P-3).

2. At the very outset, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that he served legal notice dated August 19, 2017 upon the respondents, which do not fetch any reply. He further submits that he also filed various representations including representation dated May 18, 2017 but till date no action has been taken. He further submits that he feels satisfied in case a direction is issued to respondent No.2 to consider and dispose of the legal notice (Annexure P-6) within a stipulated period.

3. Accordingly, instant petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2 to look into the grievances unfolded by the petitioner in the legal notice (Annexure P-6) and take a conscious decision in accordance with law within a period of three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order. However, if the petitioner still feels aggrieved by any order of the afore-said authority, he shall be at liberty to approach this Court.
