It is contention on behalf of the petitioner that his applications IA Nos.515 and 516 of 2017 (Annexures P7 and P8) were fixed for orders on 05.10.2017 in the DRT. But the Presiding Officer was on leave on that date and the matter was deferred to 22.11.2017. Thereafter, respondent No.1 issued a letter (Annexure P11) dated 09.10.2017 from which it transpires that process is on to dispossess the petitioner on 13.10.2017. The contention in this regard is that such a process would render his pending applications infructuous.

In the circumstances, the matter is disposed off with a direction that the petitioner's dispossession in terms of the letter (Annexure P11) shall remain stayed till 22.11.2017 on which date appropriate orders may be passed by the learned DRT.
