Learned counsel for the petitioners prays for withdrawal of the present petition as at present, the petitioner does not have any evidence to show that respondent No. 3 has illegally encroached upon the land of the Gram Panchayat after becoming Sarpanch and is liable to be put under suspension. He further submits that he has applied for the information under the Right to Information Act, 2005 which would take some time.

In view of the above, the present petition is dismissed as withdrawn at this stage with liberty to the petitioner that in case he obtains the evidence that respondent No. 3 had taken the possession on the land of the Gram Panchayat after becoming the Sarpanch, then he can file a fresh petition.
