One of the preliminary objections of the petitioners is that though there were 13 applications filed by the co-sharers for seeking partition of the joint khewat in which total land is 517 kanal 11 marla yet the applications have been entertained in respect of only 476 kanal 12 marla of land, therefore, it is allegedly a case of partial partition. The said arguments was allegedly raised before the AC 1st Grade but it is alleged that he has not dealt with it either way.

In view thereof, learned counsel for the petitioners prays for withdrawal of the petition in order to invoke Section 15 of the Punjab Land Revenue Act, 1887 for the purpose of seeking review of the order passed by AC 1st Grade with an observations that his argument has not been dealt with by the competent court.

Dismissed as withdrawn.
