The petitioner seeks quashing of the order dated 06.-09.2017 (Annexure P-2), whereby she has been transferred from Government Senior Secondary School, Bitna (3718), Block Pinjore, District Panchkula to Government Senior Secondary School, Boh (18), Block Ambala-II (Cantt.), District Ambala against a clear vacancy.

It is the case of the petitioner that she had applied for the District Hisar and on account of her merit, her rank was 5 and in spite of that she has been sent to Ambala. It is also the case of the petitioner that a request was made on the Portal and even thereafter a detailed representation dated 11.09.2017 has also been moved (Annexure P-4 colly.) to the respondent No.1 regarding this aspect.

A perusal of the latest representation dated 11.09.2017 would go on to show that the details have been mentioned that persons junior to her have been transferred at District Hisar who are now arrayed as private respondents.

Counsel submits that he would be satisfied if a time bound decision is taken on the said representation.

Notice of motion.

Ms. Shruti Jain Goyal, AAG, Haryana accepts notice on behalf of respondents No.1 and 2. Copy of the paper-book has been supplied.

Keeping in view the above, no useful purpose will be served by calling upon the respondents and to file reply, since the decision making process is not complete.

Accordingly, without commenting upon the merits of the case or the entitlement of the petitioner, the present writ petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.1 to take a decision on the said issue within a period of two week from the receipt of the certified copy of this order.

It is, however, made clear that if the private respondents are to be disturbed, appropriate notice will be issued to them before passing of any order, so that it does not lead to unnecessary litigation in this regard.
