Petitioner has prayed for a writ for a direction to the respondents to reconstitute the letter of intent as husband of petitioner namely, Maharaj Beer Singh, who was partner of M/s Namdhari Oil Agency, died. In view of registered Will dated 5.10.2008 left by him, petitioner is entitled to step into his shoes and LOI needs to be reconstituted accordingly.

Mr. Kapoor, learned counsel appearing for respondent Corporation at the outset submits that petitioner submitted an incomplete application, which has been returned to her. In case a fresh application complete in all respects is submitted by her within two weeks from today, same shall be considered as per norms and a decision thereon shall be taken within one month thereof.

In view of above, no further direction is necessary. Petition is hereby disposed of.
