The petitioner has approached this Court under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of *certiorari*, quashing the order dated 13.07.2017 (Annexure P-1) passed by respondent No.2. A further writ of *mandamus* has been sought for directing the respondents to refund the security amount of ₹ 3,06,000/- with interest @12% per month, withheld by respondent No.2.

2. After hearing the learned counsel for the petitioner, we find that certain disputed questions of fact are required to be established by leading evidence.

3. Accordingly, a prayer was made that he may be allowed to withdraw the present writ petition with liberty to the petitioner to take recourse to the remedies either by way of civil suit or other alternative remedy in accordance with law.

4. Dismissed as withdrawn. However, it shall be open to the petitioner to take recourse to the remedies as may be available to him, in accordance with law.
