With the intervention of Lok Adalat, the parties have agreed that the amount of compensation granted to the appellant could be enhanced by a sum of Rs.40,000/- in addition to the amount of Rs.62,105/- already granted. The compensation for the injuries suffered by the appellant is enhanced by lump sum amount of Rs.40,000/-. The liability to pay the enhanced compensation will be of all the respondents jointly and severally. The amount will be released by the Insurance Company within a period of two months from today. In case of failure to pay the enhanced amount, the appellant will be entitled to interest at the rate of 6 per cent per annum from the date of this award. The amount will be deposited with the Lok Adalat branch of this Court and will be disbursed to the appellant forthwith.

The appeal is disposed of accordingly.
