In this writ petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, the petitioner has prayed for issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari for setting/quashing the impugned order dated 12.10.2017 (Annexure P-2) passed by respondent No.2, vide which bid of the petitioner with regard to E-tender bearing Reference No.CP4/2017/3049-64 (Annexure P-1) and Tender ID No.2017\_CHD\_39676\_1 under the title of “UPGRADATION RENOVATION OF 9 NOS. ROOM OF SECOND FLOOR OF OLD BLOCK ROOM Court 214 to 222 FOR PHS AT U.T. GUEST HOUSE SECTOR 6, CHANDIGARH,” invited by Chandigarh Administration, Engineering/Construction Circle, C.P. Division No.4, has been rejected and bid of respondents No.3 and 4 have been accepted wrongly, arbitrarily and against the principles of natural justice.

2. After arguing for some time, learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that he may be allowed to withdraw the present writ petition at this stage, with liberty to the petitioner to approach the respondent/authorities concerned by filing a representation.

3. Dismissed as withdrawn.

4. However, it shall be open to the petitioner to take recourse to the remedies as may be available to it, in accordance with law.
