Challenge has been raised to the transfer order dated 12/17.10.2017 (Annexure P-5) from Palwal.

Affidavit of the Registrar, Cooperative Societies, Haryana, Panchkula, has been filed, in compliance of the order dated 27.10.2017, in which, explanation has been given as to in what circumstances, the petitioner has been repeatedly transferred. It has further been mentioned that the representation dated 12.12.2017 has been received from the petitioner, for cancellation of his transfer and that the recommendation for cancellation has been given to the Government for approval, keeping in view the family circumstances of the petitioner. Relevant portion of the affidavit dated 14.12.2017 reads as under:

“4. That after receiving the representation dated 12.12.2017 from the petitioner that his transfer orders may be cancelled due to paralytic mother. The matter has been examined in view of transfer policy 2004-05 and family circumstances of the petitioner, representation dated 12.12.2017 has been considered by the undersigned and recommended for cancellation of transfer orders of the petitioner to the Govt. for kind approval.”

Accordingly, keeping in view the above, the present writ petition is disposed of, by binding down respondent No.2, with the terms of the affidavit.
