The petitioner seeks directions to the respondents to allow her to continue till the regular appointments are made and not to relieve her during the vacations.

A perusal of the experience certificate dated 12.6.2017 (Annexure P/8) would go on to show that the petitioner is no longer in service since April, 2017. Further the legal notice dated 11.6.2017 (Annexure P/13) served upon the respondents verifies the said fact. Resultantly, if the petitioner has any grievance regarding fixing of minimum pay scale or any other grievance, it is always open to her to approach the Educational Tribunal at Kaithal, headed by the District Judge, in view of the notification issued by this Court and by the State Government.

In view of the alternative remedy available, this Court is not willing to exercise its discretionary jurisdiction in view of the law laid down by the Apex Court in **United Bank of India Vs. Satyawati Tandon & others 2010 (8) SCC 110.**

Accordingly, the present writ petition is dismissed in limine and the petitioner is relegated to the remedy mentioned above.
