By this short order, two writ petitions are being disposed of, i.e.

CWP-4142-2015 and CWP-6462-2015.

It is not disputed even by the respondents, as per their reply, that the petitioners have not been relieved from service (atleast certainly till the date of filing of the reply) and as per para no. 5 of the preliminary submissions, the process of filling up the posts “on regular basis was in progress.”

Since the work is obviously available for various posts in view of the fact that such posts are sought to be filled up by 'regular employees', consequently, these petitions are disposed of with a direction that the

petitioners would not be replaced by contractual/daily-wage/non-regularly selected employees, till regular appointments are made. If at any stage it is found by the respondent-Department that work is not available for any of the petitioners on a particular post, they would be at liberty to file an appropriate application giving therein the details of non-availability of work.
