In the instant writ petition, petitioner has challenged the award passed by the Labour court dated 22.2.2017 (Annexure P1). Perusal of the labour court award in particularly para 12 it is evident that there is in action on the part of the petitioner. If their contention is that respondent-workman has abandoned the services it was bounden duty of the petitioner to issue necessary letter or communication asking the respondent-workman to report back to duty. No such document has been placed. What has been placed is only relating to payment of salary for a particular period. Thus petitioner have not made out a case so as to interfere with the Labour Court award dated 22.02.2017 (Annexure P1).

Accordingly, CWP stands dismissed.
