Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that even though 70 posts of Malis were advertised by the respondent-Forest Department of the Government of Haryana, vide Annexure P-1, all the said posts were never filled up and 10 posts are still lying vacant, with the petitioner never having been called for an interview even at that stage.

This petition having been filed more than 4 years after the aforesaid advertisement issued, firstly it is highly belated in my opinion and secondly, whether or not thereafter any other advertisement was issued to fill up the posts in question, is not known to this Court.

Consequently, without making any comment at all on the merits of the petitioners' contention, this petition is dismissed but with a liberty to the petitioner to file a representation to the respondents, which would be

considered and decided by the respondents on its own merit, within a period of three months from the date of receipt of such representation.
