Smt. Usha has approached this Court seeking a Writ of Mandamus to direct the respondent-Punjab Water Supply & Sewerage Board to consider the claim of her daughter for appointment on compassionate basis on the ground that her husband, who was serving as a Sewerage Man, died on 1.2.2017 in harness.

The relevant policy/instructions on the strength of which such a prayer has been raised, has neither been placed on record nor adverted to during the course of arguments.

Under such circumstances, prayer of the petitioner cannot even be examined.

Writ petition is disposed of as withdrawn with liberty to file a petition afresh with better particulars and by placing on record the necessary documents/material.
