Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that through the instant petition, petitioner has sought the quashing of order dated January 22, 2016 (P-5) passed by respondent No.2, whereby petitioner has been dismissed from service. But while filing the instant petition, he could not claim the benefit of pension as well as other pensionary benefits. He further submits that though amount(s) of Gratuity as well as Leave Encashment have already been paid but with a considerable delay and no interest on delayed payments thereof has been granted. Thus, he seeks to withdraw the instant petition with permission to file a fresh one with better particulars as well as to seek the relief of pension and other pensionary benefits as well as the interest on delayed payments.
