The petitioners are residents of village Rahra, Tehsil Assandh, District Karnal. They allege that official respondents and the Gram Panchayat of their village is taking no action for removal of encroachments from the *shamlat land* comprising the village Johar despite the eviction order dated 13.05.2014 (P-2) having been passed against the private-respondents, followed by orders of appointing Duty Magistrate and for providing police help for removal of encroachments. It is alleged that due to political influence and other extraneous reasons, the encroachments are not being removed.

Having heard learned counsel for the petitioners but without expressing any views on merits, however, keeping in view the categorical stand taken before us that eviction order dated 13.05.2014 has attained finality and that no action is being taken to give effect to the same, the writ petition is disposed of with a direction to the (i) Deputy Commissioner, Karnal; (ii) Superintendent of Police, Karnal and (iii) D.D.P.O., Karnal to take cognizance of the above-mentioned grievance of the petitioners and

take necessary action as may be required in furtherance of the eviction

order, referred to above, strictly in accordance with law. The needful shall be done within a period of three months from the date of receiving a certified copy of this order.

Ordered accordingly.
