S.J.VAZIFDAR, Chief Justice :

The petitioner's grievance is that the respondents have failed and neglected to hand over possession of the plot, which was allotted to him vide letter dated 02.04.2012. He states that three instalments have been paid. Repeated requests have been made for possession of the plot, but of no avail. The petitioner apprehends that the plot, in fact, may have been encroached upon. The respondents are not responding to his representations and legal notice over the years, the last of which is dated 06.09.2017 (Annexure P-8).

The petition is, therefore, disposed of by directing the respondents to take a decision on the petitioner's representations including the one dated 06.09.2017 (Annexure P-8) and inform the petitioner about the same in writing by 15.12.2017. The respondents shall also state, as to what relief would be given to the petitioner, in the event it being found that the petitioner is allottee of the plot, but the respondents are not able to hand over possession thereof to him for any reason.
