The instant writ petition has been filed under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India seeking issuance of a writ in the nature of Certiorari for quashing the appointment of respondent No. 5 to the post of Lady Warden, Bathinda, who was appointed ignoring the percentage of marks obtained by the petitioner.

At the time of hearing, short affidavit on behalf of respondent

No. 3 has been filed in Court. The same is taken on record. A copy thereof has been supplied to the counsel opposite.

As per the short affidavit filed, the case of the petitioner has been considered and appointment has been offered to her to the post of Lady Warden at Senior Secondary Residential School of Meritorious Students, Gurdaspur.

In view of the fact that the petitioner has been offered appointment, this writ petition is being disposed of giving liberty to the petitioner to revive the instant writ petition in case any grievance is still surviving.
