The petitioner is aggrieved by order dated 25.10.2017 (Annexure P-2), whereby, he has been relieved and has been directed to give his presence at Government Senior Secondary School, Lehri, Talwandi Sabo, Bathinda.

Said transfer order has been challenged by the petitioner only on the ground that he is going to retire from service today i.e 31.10.2017.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has been transferred just to create inconvenience in releasing the pensionary benefits.

Notice of motion.

On the asking of the Court, Ms. Akshita Chauhan, A.A.G., Punjab, who is present in the Court, accepts notice on behalf of respondent-State and submits that she sought an information from the respondent on mobile that there was a complaint against the petitioner and transfer is

within the district. She further submits that the petitioner is not going to be affected in any manner as far as release of pensionary benefits are concerned.

In view of submissions made by learned counsel for the parties, nothing survives in the petition as the grievance of the petitioner is only that he may not be harassed with regard to release of pensionary benefits.

Keeping in view the grievance of the petitioner, the respondent authorities are directed to make all efforts to release the pensionary benefits to the petitioner within the reasonable time.

The petition is disposed of accordingly.
