The Court is happy to note that good office of Mr. Anil Shukla, Advocate, has able to persuade the management to settle the disputes between the parties on payment of ₹6.5 lakhs as lump sum compensation towards all the claims except provident fund subscriptions which lie with the management till 2009. A representative of the family of the workman who is stated to be a patient of cancer, is present in Court by the name of Sh. Rajinder Singh (brother-in-law of the respondent-workman). The compromise will be read as an undertaking to the Court. The amount will be paid to the workman on the date notified by the respondent-workman when he would tender his resignation from service. If the respondent is not physically fit to travel he may send his resignation letter through his brother-in-law Sh. Rajinder Singh. The workman will inform the management the

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Bank account number where the compensatory amount will transfer through RTGS. On the workman approaching the management with an application for payment of his provident fund dues, the management will certify the application form leaving it free to the workman to approach the employees Provident Fund Organization for release of money.

With this, the file is closed.
