At least at this stage we do not find any reason to interfere. Learned counsel for the petitioners states that he is willing to appear before the Director, Food, Civil Supplies and Consumer Affairs, Punjab and shall produce all the relevant documents in support of his plea for allocation of paddy for milling purposes for the current season 2016-17. If that is so, then evidently there is no impediment in the way of the appellants to approach the Director concerned. In case he does so and looking at the constraints of the milling season which is captive to time, we would expect an expeditious decision at the hands of the Director, preferably within two days from the date when he is approached in this regard.
