Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the Permanent Lok Adalat (PUS), Kaithal [for short 'the PLA'] has passed the impugned order in a manner deciding the public interest litigation.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner.

The application had been filed by the resident of the area, who has been facing problem of garbage being piled up because the Municipal Council, Kaithal was not performing its duty as provided in the Haryana Municipal Act, 1973 [for short 'the Act'], therefore, the PLA had to come to his rescue by issuing directions to the Municipal Council which is otherwise its duty to perform under the Act.

Thus, in view of the above, there is hardly any reason with this Court to interfere in this petition and as such the same is hereby dismissed.
