SURYA KANT, J. (Oral)

(1) In compliance and continuation of the order dated 02.05.2017, learned counsel for Punjab Financial Corporation states that possession has already been received from three writ petitioners whereas one Jasbir Singh who had filed separate writ petition and which stands disposed of, has not handed over possession so far and police help has been sought. Since the said Jasbir Singh is retaining possession forcibly in violation of the Court order, the SSP, SAS Nagar Mohali is directed to provide police assistance forthwith and ensure that physical possession is restored in favour of the Corporation.

(2) As regard to petitioners No.1 to 3, namely, Dheeraj Wadhwa, Shiv Lal Yadav, Ashok Kumar and one Tilak Raj Sharma, their learned counsel undertakes to hand over the physical possession within 10 days. So far as Riyasat Ali – petitioner No.4 is concerned, it is stated that he has paid user charges for two months. He also undertakes that the physical possession shall be handed over on or before 10.07.2017.

(3) In view of the above undertakings and directions, the writ petition is disposed of.
