The petitioners at this stage seek an order directing the respondents to consider the application for transfer of 1/3rd share in the property which belongs to their paternal grand-mother, who is stated to have died intestate. The deceased has two other sons, one of whom has also died. His children have also made an application for transfer of their share in the property to them. 3rd son of the deceased is alive and would, therefore, also be entitled to 1/3rd share at this stage.

We do not express any view upon the contention of the petitioners and their entitlement to have the property transferred in their names.

The matter has been pending for over two years before the authorities.

The petition is, therefore, disposed of by directing the respondents to take the decision on the petitioner's application by 31.01.2018.
